## What to expect when becoming a Trustee?

We understand that becoming a Trustee may feel daunting! Our existing Trustees and Staff team have compiled the following description to give you an idea of being a Trustee involves:



Ensure the charity manages its resources, including our finances and staff teams responsibly.

Trust and encourage the staff team. Give guidance and support.

Share your lived experience, knowledge, and skills.

Read, review, and provide comments to our policies and procedures.


Commit to and attend at least five meetings per year.

Be a supporter of our programme, attend events and promote our work.

Be a critical friend- providing constructive challenges when needed.

Be a team player and be supportive of fellow Trustees & staff.

Ensure Cartwheel meets our legal requirements, this includes having correct process, procedures and always acting for the public benefit.



If you do not currently feel that you have all the required skills and experience but are committed and willing to learn – we welcome your application, providing you have the time to learn these skills and responsibilities within your first six months of Trusteeship.
